

Dropshare for macOS

Dropshare is a menu bar application for file sharing. It works with several different storage providers and brings an own, free-to-use storage provider named Dropshare Cloud.

Multiple connections can be set up to easily switch between different contexts and upload destinations, e.g. by user-defined keyboard shortcuts.

Features

Uploads everything

No matter if files, folders, text or screenshots – the app uploads every file and data to your selected destination - also from clipboard or other applications like Safari. It includes a native macOS Share Extension and thus integrates in almost any other app seamlessly.

Share and annotate screenshots

Set up your own keyboard shortcuts for full screen or selection-based screenshots that'll be uploaded automatically. Set up a custom keyboard shortcut for taking a screenshot and annotating it afterwards with the app itself, or a third-party app you already use: Preview, Skitch, Napkin, Annotate or CleanShot (X).

Screen Recordings

Take & upload Screen Recordings directly with the app, both fullscreen and selection-based recordings are available, as well as GIF conversion. Videos can be recorded with 24 or 60 FPS.

Beautiful individual landing pages

Choose from several free designs or craft an individual design using HTML, CSS and JavaScript, including upload previews for images, videos and text files.

Dropshare Sync

Synchronize your upload history across all your devices, supports both iOS and macOS, works with iCloud. No setup required, works out of the box.

URL Shortener

Upload URLs can be automatically shortened with a URL shortener services of your choice – either the built-in dsh.re, Rebrandly, bit.ly, short.io, kutt.it or a custom (or self-hosted) URL shortener like YOURLS.

More

There are more features available which can be individually configured, e.g.:

- Command Line Interface
- Upload Zone on desktop for quick and easy upload
- Markdown notes to HTML
- Secure download links with password and expiry
- Screen capture from iOS and Android devices
- ...

Requirements

Please mind the following requirements in order to use Dropshare for macOS:

Dropshare Cloud

Different plans available, including a free plan and complimentary plan for Setapp customers.

SCP (over SSH) & SFTP

A working SSH user account is required on the server. A password or SSH key pair is also required. To have the uploaded file displayed in a web browser, a web server needs to be installed and configured on the server.

FTP/FTPS

A working FTP user account is required on the server. To have the uploaded file displayed in a web browser, a web server needs to be installed and configured on the server.

WebDAV

A WebDAV module needs to be activated for the web server. To have the uploaded file displayed in a web browser, the web server needs to be configured on the remote server.

S3 API-compliant service

Dropshare supports services like OpenStack Swift. Check our User Guide for more information.

Dropbox, OneDrive, Google Drive, Box, pCloud

An account is required.
